
Read the information on the layers of the skin

The skin consists of three main layers:

- Epidermis
- Dermis
- Subcutaneous layer




Layers of the Skin





The epidermis layer of the skin which has living cells at its base and dead hardened cells at its outer surface.

The epidermis has five different layers:



The Dermis


• BURY • • This is the inner layer of the skin, situated under the epidermis.

 The layer is composed of dense connective tissue and contains blood vessels, nerves, sweat glands, sebaceous glands and hair follicles.





- The bottom layer of skin is the subcutaneous fat layer. This layer plays an important role in your body by:
- Controlling your body temperature
- Storing your fat
