A LEVELS

- Study **THREE** A Level subjects (four by exception)
- May include one Applied A Level subject
- Two-year course
- Assessment is predominantly exam based
- Group and one-to-one tutorials
- May include one Applied A Level subject (including V Levels, due to be available from September 2027)

2

T LEVELS

- Study **ONE** T Level
- Two-year technical course
- Assessment is a combination of exams, practical skills tests and employer set projects
- A minimum 45-day (315 hour) industry placement
- Group and one-to-one tutorials

3

VOCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

- Study **ONE** vocational subject
- One or two-year course depending on level and qualification
- Available from Entry Level up to Level 3
- Assessment is predominantly practical and coursework based
- Group and one-to-one tutorials

APPRENTICESHIPS

- A full-time job with a recognised qualification
- Study **ONE** subject
- Earn a salary
- Use approximately 20% of your working hours to complete your studies
- Gain practical work-based experience
