THE NEXT LEVEL QUALIFICATION



WHAT IS A T LEVEL?

- A T Level is a highly technical qualification which is equivalent to three A Levels, and so is a pathway to university
- T Levels combine classroom learning (80%) with on-the-job work experience (20%)
- Students complete a minimum 45 day industry placement to gain experience in a real workplace setting

WHO IS A T LEVEL RIGHT FOR?

- Those who want to gain workplace experience alongside their learning
- Those who want to pursue a high-quality technical route into skilled employment, further study, or a higher/degree apprenticeship

WHERE CAN A T LEVEL TAKE ME?



Leoni studied T Level Education and Early Years: Assisting Teaching, and progressed to Manchester Metropolitan University to study Primary Teaching with QTS.



Joseph studied T Level Mechanical Engineering, and progressed to a Nuclear Engineering Degree Apprenticeship at Rolls-Royce.

Carson studied T Level Management and Administration, and secured a permanent position after his placement at LGC.

- What additional support exists from tutors outside of lesson time?


About life at Bury College
