

A Typical Day

If you are an independent traveller you will walk through the Millennium building to get to Prospects. Remember to wear your college ID badge at all times as you will need it to scan in when entering the college. There will be college staff at the entrance to assist you.

If you travel by transport or get dropped off. Please go to the drop off point near Fisherfields nursery based at the back of the Millennium campus. An Educational Support Worker will meet you there and take you to the canteen or your classroom.

Classes tend to start at 9am and finish at 4pm. Your group tutor will send you a timetable to confirm your days and start / finish times. If you use transport, please contact your local authority transport department to arrange.

An example of a typical day (times may vary depending on your course).

9.00am Go to class

10.30am Break – 20mins

10.50am Go back to the same class

12.00 – 1pm Dinner

1pm Go to class

2pm Break – 20mins

4pm Finish

Every Monday and Tuesday you can get your dinner from the Smart Café. You can also buy from the Pavilion canteen or bring a packed lunch. If you prefer a quieter environment, you can eat in the designated Quiet room which is staffed by Educational Support Workers. If you are independent you can go out of the college for dinner.
